NOTICE OF MEETING

NOTICE is hereby given that a general meeting of the subscribers to the British School of Archæology in Iraq (Gertrude Bell Memorial) Appeal Fund will be held at the Hall of the British Academy, Burlington Gardens, W.1, on Thursday, the 14th day of January, 1932, at half-past three p.m., for the purpose of transacting the following business:

1. To receive and, if thought fit, to approve the Report of the Executive Committee and the Accounts of the Appeal Fund.

2. To approve the establishment of a British School of Archæology in Iraq (Gertrude Bell Memorial), and to consider and, if thought fit, to approve the Regulations for the said School, a copy of which, as recommended by the Executive Committee of the Appeal Fund, accompanies this notice.

3. To elect not more than 25 persons as members of the Council of the said School to hold office respectively until the first annual general meeting of the School.

(The Draft Regulations provide that in addition to the members so appointed there will be Life Members and Members appointed by certain Academic and other Bodies.)

4. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution: that all investments now held for or on account of the Appeal Fund be transferred to, or in trust for the British School of Archæology in Iraq (Gertrude Bell Memorial) upon trust to be held as an endowment, to be administered by the Council of the said School for the purposes of the School: and that all cash property and rights (other than the said investments) held for or on account of the Appeal Fund, after payment of any outstanding liabilities, be transferred to the said School.

5. To transact any other business which may be properly brought before the meeting.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

THE Executive Committee have pleasure in submitting their report on the progress of the Fund.

The Fund was inaugurated at a meeting held in the Hall of the British Academy on July 16th, 1929, with Major-General Sir Percy Cox in the Chair. The meeting having unanimously approved of the establishment of a British School of Archæology in Iraq, to be directed by a Council in England, appointed a General Committee and an Executive Committee for the purpose of collecting funds for the School and of taking all other action to bring it into being.

The first work of the Executive Committee was to draw up a prospectus on which to issue the appeal for funds. It was necessary for this purpose to define the main objects of the School. They were defined as follows:

- “ 1. To encourage, support and undertake the study of and research relating to the archæology of Iraq and neighbouring countries, including excavation.
2. To afford to British students by means of scholarships, travelling fellowships, or other facilities, opportunities for the study of the archæology of Iraq and the neighbouring countries.

(At present a student of the archæology of Iraq receives little encouragement in Great Britain. Not a single scholarship or travelling fellowship devoted to the subject exists. One of the main objects of the School will be to train scholars and fit them to undertake research or to fill administrative posts in Iraq.)

3. To publish from time to time a journal devoted to the activities of the School and to the archæology of Iraq and the neighbouring countries.

(The need for such a journal has long been felt in England, where no specialist publication of the kind exists to-day.)

4. To co-operate freely with other archæological organisations carrying on work in Iraq and neighbouring countries."

After much preparatory work, the appeal was issued in the autumn of 1929. A meeting in support was held at the Central Hall, Westminster, on Friday, November 8th, 1929. Major-General Sir Percy Cox was in the Chair and the speakers included the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Right Hon. L. S. Amery, M.P., the Viscountess Astor, M.P., Sir Frederic Kenyon and Sir Francis Humphrys. The Rt. Hon. J. Ramsay MacDonald, M.P., who had hoped to be present and address the meeting, was prevented by public business from attending and wrote sending his best wishes for the success of the appeal. The speeches were followed by an address by the late Dr. H. R. Hall on "Recent Discoveries in Iraq," illustrated by lantern slides. The hall was crowded to overflowing.

The following articles specially written for the occasion were published in the Press: "New Letters of Gertrude Bell," by the late Lady Bell, published in *The Times*; "Gertrude Bell in Iraq," by Sir Edgar Bonham Carter, published in the *Daily Telegraph*; "A British School of Archæology in Iraq," by Lt.-General Sir George MacMunn, published in the *Illustrated London News*, and "The British School of Archæology in Iraq (Gertrude Bell Memorial)," by V. Sackville-West (The Hon. Mrs. Harold Nicolson), published in *Time and Tide*.

On June 3rd, 1930, Mr. C. Leonard Woolley gave a lecture on behalf of the Fund, at the Central Hall, Westminster, on Recent Excavations at Ur. The lecture was well attended and resulted in a profit of £78 16s. 9d. Lectures given by Lady Richmond at the Aeolian Hall, London, and at Rounton, Halifax and Huddersfield, added £66 10s. 6d. to the Fund.

The audited accounts of the Fund showing receipts and payments to the 30th day of April, 1931, are presented herewith.

Since the date of the audit, additional sums have been received and payments made, and the result of the Appeal down to November 11th, 1931, may be summarised as follows:

In addition the Fund had promises of future payments of Donations, payable by annual instalments, amounting to 1,013 17 0
And promises of annual Subscriptions, amounting to 14 8 0

The total result of the Appeal down to Nov. 11, 1931, taking the 100 Thos. W. Ward Ltd. Pref. Shares at par and including future instalments of Donations, but excluding future payments of annual Subscriptions, amounted to £9,359 15 0.

The total expenditure down to November 11, 1931, amounted to £243 5s. 10d., which is equivalent to 2.76 per cent. only of the cash receipts.

The above receipts are in addition to the legacy of £6,000 bequeathed by the late Gertrude Bell to the Trustees of the British Museum upon trust to pay over the income to a British School of Archæology in Iraq, if such a school should be founded within twenty-one years of her death, and to use in the meantime the income for archæological work in Iraq.

The endowment created by Miss Bell has recently been most generously increased by Sir Hugh Bell. For by his will, he bequeathed "to the persons or body to whom the late Gertrude Bell bequeathed a legacy of £6,000" a legacy of £4,000 (subject to payment of death duties) upon trust to apply the income for the promotion of archæological research in Iraq.

While the Committee are most grateful to subscribers for the considerable measure of success which has been attained, the result falls short of the sum of £14,000 which the Executive Committee, as announced at the public meeting of November 8th, 1929, aimed at raising. Under these circumstances the Committee have anxiously considered what action should now be taken.

The present organisation was formed for the purpose of collecting funds and to bring a British School of Archæology into being. It has not itself the power to apply the income of the funds which it has collected to archæological purposes.

It might continue the Appeal conserving the funds. But in view of the wide appeal which has already been made and the present state of financial depression in this country, the Executive Committee are of opinion that a further appeal at the present time is not likely to be successful.

The alternative course, which the Committee recommend, is to constitute the organisation in England for a British School of Archæology in Iraq, and to hand over the funds to such organisation.

With the funds at present available, the School could only commence operations on a limited scale. But by co-operation with the British Museum or with other archæological organisations carrying on work in Iraq, it could employ the whole or part of the income derived from existing

endowments usefully and economically. It could for instance support one of the archæological expeditions carrying on work in Iraq and establish one or more scholarships or travelling fellowships for British students. And it would be in a position to appeal for annual subscriptions to carry on its work and, when the opportunity is favourable, for further endowments.

The Committee therefore recommend that the necessary resolutions be passed for establishing a British School of Archæology in Iraq (Gertrude Bell Memorial), for approving Regulations for the School, and for the transfer of the funds and property of the present Appeal Fund to or in trust for the School.

The Committee deplore the death of some of the most active supporters of the Fund. Dr. H. R. Hall, Keeper of Egyptian and Assyrian Antiquities in the British Museum, was a member of the Executive Committee and freely devoted both his time and his great ability to the furtherance of the Appeal. Sir Israel Gollancz, the Secretary of the British Academy, welcomed the proposal for the establishment of a British School of Archæology in Iraq and was helpful in many ways. Sir Gilbert Clayton, the late High Commissioner in Iraq was an early and enthusiastic supporter of the Scheme. The Committee deeply regret that neither Sir Hugh nor Lady Bell, to whose encouragement and fruitful co-operation such success as the Appeal has attained is in no small measure due, have lived to see the realisation of their daughter's wish by the establishment of the School. They offer to the family of Sir Hugh and Lady Bell their heartfelt sympathy in their loss.

In conclusion, the Committee desire to express their grateful thanks to all who by their donations or services have contributed to the success of the Appeal. In particular, they would express their thanks to the Royal Geographical Society, the Royal Asiatic Society, the Royal Central Asian Society, the Royal Institute of British Architects, the University of Durham, Lady Margaret Hall, Oxford, Magdalen College, Oxford, and the Old Queen's Society, Harley Street, London, for their donations and support: to Sir Charles Hyde, Bart., Mrs. William H. Moore, Dr. Henry S. Wellcome, and Dr. William Rushton Parker for

their munificent gifts: to the Archbishop of Canterbury, Mr. Amery, the Viscountess Astor, Sir Frederic Kenyon and Sir Francis Humphrys for their presence and speeches at the public meeting: to the late Lady Bell, Lt.-General Sir George MacMunn and the Hon. Mrs. Harold Nicolson for their articles in support of the Appeal: to Mr. C. Leonard Woolley for his lecture: to the British Academy for the loan of their Hall and Council Room: to Mr. H. T. Montague Bell and Mr. Kenneth Williams, Editor of *The Near East and India*, for valuable help in connection with publicity: to Mr. Harold Lakeman of the firm of Messrs. Morrish, Grant and Co., for his service as Honorary Auditor, and to Messrs.
